The home has excellent transport links to the nearest town centre (Dover) and further afield, and allows easy access to a number of nearby local schools, as well as indoor and outdoor activities where young people can engage in their existing or newly found hobbies and interests.

Our dedicated house team also work closely alongside our in-house, multidisciplinary therapy team, fostering and education teams as part of our wider therapeutic community and can provide:

✓ ADHD/ Autism assessments completed within 8 weeks.

✓ Our unique Stepping Stones program settles and emotionally prepares our children for living as part of a fostering family.

We aspire to create a warm and nurturing environment where children feel supported and valued. Our dedicated team of professionals work closely with each child to tailor care to their individual needs, helping them build the confidence, resilience, and life skills for a brighter future.
